XI. OLD BUSINESS BEFORE THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- 1) Water Leak Need to keep looking for the leak as it was not where Fred thought it was. Farren states it is in the front half of the range. Farren and Russell are still looking into walking the line.
- 2) Break between 9 & 10 Fred states he would like to put blocks between. Farren states he has blocks he can donate. They will have a report on what it will take to make this happen.
- 3) Helipad Fred would like to put a red "x" with rocks painted white on the corners.
- 4) RV park water 50% of the ditch has been dug. The items for the project need to be bought. It will take another month to at least as the schedules need to be aligned. Asking for Craig to come with tractor to help dig ditch.
- 5) 1000 yard range update by Mike. Last month it was stated in front of Matt that we will never have the concrete and the overheads on the 500 meter. A proposal was given to the board. Mike stated that Fred stated it sounded good. Mike, Stan, Larry and Seth moved some of the targets from the 500 meter range. Used a tractor to build up the berms. Targets at the berms are being stated to be concreted. Farren asked for where the placement of the conex box needs to be done. Behind 0 & 1 there is wood. Craig stated he has concrete piers for a footer for the conex.
- 6) Jim Merritt Electronic targets/wood The wood needs to be replaced and that will be about \$500.00. On the electronic targets will be approximately \$4000. Four sensors on each target. Four units for controlling scores. Fred stated Matt offered cardboard. The vinyl target are all hung. There is a good investment to upgrade the range. Vicki motioned for the \$4000.and Jim seconded.

- 1) Conex to be moved the conex from the 500 meter to the 1000 yard. Mike will cut locks on the conex's and inventory to be able to see what are in there. Mike was asked where the conex box will be placed. Farren and Mike will get together to figure out placement.
- 2) Scoring stand skeet #1 Farren states the flooring and the footing needs to be leveled.
- 3) RV hose If there needs to be an extension from an RV to the water. We can buy them for \$16.95 sell for \$20.00. Just for information sake.
- 4) Conex M007 & M008 Has private locks. Mike is gonna cut locks and inventory. Vicki brought up items

that are on the inventory we are paying taxes on. Some things are listed and some are not. Will email listing to all officers.

- 5) No smoking or tobacco in RSO Some complaints have come in from members that it is unprofessional to have chewing tobacco or other tobacco products while on shift. There should not be any tobacco allowed in the office.
- 6) Probation The probation office has given us a chance to use probationary persons to come out and do work. The insurance would be the probation departments issue. Farren made motion and Craig Seconded. It was signed by Fred. Farren will be the contact for this.
