RANGE REPORT: Victor Perez read Range numbers. Stated he had 3 people show up at the range while he was working on May 3rd that stated they were supposed to be having a CCW class but there was no notification to the range office or the CRSO of such a class. Vicki explained that the person who was supposed to be running the class did not have permissions to hold said class at the range. He had called and stated it was a mix up on his website and that he was terribly sorry. This person was supposed to already have given his credentials to the range office and it had not been done so far so at this time we want nothing to do with this gentlemen. Farren was asked to contact the gentlemen and explain we do not want him to come out and hold any classes.

Directors and volunteers are not paying for the shoots. Some are saying they were told since they spend a lot of hours setting up that they could let their volunteers and Directors not pay. This has not been a directive of this board. In the SOP it states all Directs and all who are on the shoot sheets need to pay. Larry makes a motion to uphold the SOP. Farren states the ruling has already been made as it is in the SOP so there is no need of a motion.

Volunteers for Brass. Victor would like to have a plaque for Thomas Tallman and 50 dollar gift certificate for them to Thomas and Bob Waller.

IX. OLD BUSINESS BEFORE THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

1) 1000 yard range update – Larry stated the frames are painted and the electronic targets are working great. The only other thing a trying to get a conex for the 1000 yard range. Had the shoot to raise money and it did well but it brought in 480 for the conex. Larry makes a motion for the club to bay the other part of the funds to get a conex. The conex will cost 2500. Farren makes a motion to table that for right now. Farren states he thinks there is a conex box. Vicki seconded. Farren states it will stay tabled until there is more information brought forward for it to be put back on the agenda. All were in favor.

2) Fishing for Smiles – looking for a head count as to how many are going. So far there are three. Farren states that Fred Herring states they have already done the special needs day and this Saturday will be the rest of the participants. They are looking at approximately 400 people signed up.

X. NEW BUSINESS BEFORE THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- 1) Dave updates – Monday he is meeting with the Junior Marines so he can create a program for them. Mohave Greens will host the programs but with input and help from the other directors of the disciplines. Craig, Jim and Larry all stated they would be more than willing to help. The range has 2 – 1022, 2 rimfire pistols, there is even a couple long range guns in the conex. If they do not have weapons of their own to shoot with we could offer these to them. Jim says they have adjustable turret scopes. Mitch makes a motion that MGS have the access to the weapons to start this program and will be aided by the MCS with any directors to help in this program. Vicki Seconds all board approves.
- a) Dave has contacted Ben Moyer and spent two hours with him to work on the proposal for to offer the Mohave Sportsman Club a CCW class. Ben will put this class on for free if he can hang a banner

advertising. He is proposing that the club would charge a small fee for the participants to hold down the no show factor. Then once they attend the class they would have a gift certificate to the club for money towards a day of shooting or dues or whatever. The fee and the gift certificate would be a wash. He is proposing to do the classes on Sunday after noon, Tuesday, Wednesday evenings. He would want to do it quarterly. This will only be to members not to walk ons. Vicki motion accept proposal from Bank street guns proposal to hold the classes and have the banner for advertising with the 20 dollar gift certificate. Mitch amended that once we have a full written proposal and the dates are put on the calendar with the CRSO. Jim Seconded. All were in favor no Nays.

- b) Ammunition – Sold at the range office. MCSO will be the distributor of the ammo and we will not have to buy it up front. The range office will control the inventory. If someone breaks into the office and steals it we are responsible for it. At the end of the month the amount sold will be paid back to Bank Street Guns. We will keep a commission. All sales will be run through the point of sale. The range office will be responsible for the handling and securing of the ammunition in the conex box or wherever we decide to store it. The round up for the ammunition prices would then be put into the maintenance fund. Dave asks if this is something the board is interested in. Larry asks if the range officers will be alright with this as they don't seem to have the time necessary for what is already happening in the office. CRSO Perez states they are all on board. No one in the range office has had any problems with the thought of this so far. Motion from Vicki to work with Ben Moyer to get a proposal for the selling of the ammunition. Mitch seconded. All in favor no Nays.
- c) Mohave Greens has purchased steel challenge steel. They would like to leave bay 0 and 1 for the members. He would like to use bays 2/3/4 instead. Board says acceptable.

- 2) First Friday – Fred got called from June Painter to participate in the first Friday event for June. We would need to have the materials and the individuals to staff a booth at the first Friday event. Do we want to do it? Vicki motions that we do the first Friday Larry seconded. All in favor no Nays. Fred states him and Dorothy will go. Larry says he will talk to his wife and see if they can't help out. Vicki will call the Chamber of Commerce. To get set up. Mitch states it is \$25.00 for non sales and \$60.00 a month for sales.

- 3) Brochures – three fold pamphlet needs to be updated. We have gotten an estimate for \$305.04. Mitch makes a motion for the 2500 it is 448.00. Vicki seconds. All in favor no Nays

- 4) Complaint forms – There have been 17 complaints about the hours of operations. They are recognized as being filled out and filed with the board. A response needs to be formulated and put into the website as we have recognized and understand your complaints. Vicki stated she can put something together. Larry states the whole board should be able to read it and approved. Vicki will put together and send out to board members for review.
